

Review show

Imagine that a major TV company is launching a media review show for young people which will discuss a range of new releases. On the first show the main feature will be *The Prince of Mist* and the company has managed to secure an exclusive interview with Carlos Ruiz Zafón.

Your task is to research and prepare for the show. As it is the first show, ratings will be very important so you need to address your teenage audience in an appropriate way - keep the tone lively and upbeat.

You might like to include ...



- a scripted introduction which welcomes viewers and introduces the show
- an introduction to the novel. You can include some plot details but not too much - don't ruin it for those who haven't read it!
- an introduction to the author - include some background information about him and some facts about the book (sales, awards etc)
- the trailer advertising the - find it on the author's website: www.carlosruizzafon.co.uk/prince-of-mist
- a reading of a short extract - aim to grip viewer without giving too much away
- a discussion between three or four readers - you might like to prepare some thoughtful questions to encourage debate
- readers' responses to the book - what they did or didn't enjoy
- an interview with the author - look at his website for ideas!
